- Support data collection, storage-device handling, vehicle checks, and shift handovers.
- Create accurate daily reports and issue documentation for the project team.
- Coordinate with project leads, drivers, engineers, and customer representatives.
- Follow security, confidentiality, safety, and vehicle-handling requirements.
- Work flexible schedules that may include early, late, weekend, or multi-shift operations.
- Travel between project locations based on customer and program needs.
